## Athletes' eligibility

The athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.

Only the NOCs recognized by Panam Sports whose National Federations are affiliated to World Athletics / APA may enter competitors in the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games

The NOCs may send to the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games only competitors who have qualified according to the system established by World Athletics and APA. The competitors must be U23 (born between 2003 – 2007).

Male and female athletes who compete in Throws, Heptathlon, Decathlon and 10,000, must be at least 18 years old (born between 2003 - 2006).

Any 17 year-old athlete can compete in any event with the exception of Throws, Heptathlon, Decathlon and 10,000m.

## Qualification system

Each NOC may enter a maximum of 2 (two) athletes per individual event; that is, a maximum of **40 athletes per gender**, with the following conditions:

- a) In accordance with the maximum quota of competitors per individual event, the first positions will be taken into account according to the Pan American area ranking of January 1, 2024 and until midnight of April 27, 2025, until completing the maximum quota for each event. The World Athletics ranking per event shall be used as a reference.

For the 4 x 100m and 4 x 400m relays, men and women; and 4 x 400m mixed relay, the national teams shall qualify according to the following:

The Technical Delegates and the APA will invite the national teams until completing 8 teams per relay, using as a basis the Pan American area rankings from January 1, 2024, until April 27, 2025 and will communicate this to the respective NOCs.

Each invited NOC will participate with athletes who are entered in any individual event. No athletes will be added for relays.



### **Universality quotas**

The principles of universality, parity and equity shall be observed. All NOCs are entitled to enter at least one (1) man and one (1) woman in any event. The NOCs must send their universality quotas request no later than April 25, 2025, to the following emails: [jurogo2014@gmail.com](mailto:jurogo2014@gmail.com), [asociacion.panamericana.de.atletismo@athletics.com](mailto:asociacion.panamericana.de.atletismo@athletics.com) and [andrea@panamsports.org](mailto:andrea@panamsports.org). The request must include the names of the athletes, event and mark.

### **Host country**

Paraguay will automatically qualify one (1) athlete for all Athletics event where it does not have any qualified athletes, as the host country of the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games.

### **The validity of the results must comply with the following:**

The results must be achieved in competitions organized or endorsed by World Athletics, its association in the area (NACAC/South American Athletics) or member federations. Therefore, results obtained in school or university competitions must be certified by the member federation of the country in which the competition was held.

The results must be achieved in an official competition organized according to the current regulations of World Athletics.

The results obtained in mixed events (refer to Rule 9 (RT9)) shall only be accepted under the following circumstances: For all field events and 5,000m races or longer that are held inside a stadium, the results shall be considered as follows:

- Will be automatically accepted if achieved in national competitions.
- Will only be accepted with the approval of the area's association if achieved in competitions that fulfill Rule 1.1 (i) and (j) of World Athletics.
- Will not be accepted if obtained in competitions held according to Rule 1.1 (a) to (h) of World Athletics.

Results obtained with tailwind will not be accepted.

Manually timed results will not be accepted in the 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1,500m, 110m/100 m hurdles, 400m hurdles, 4 x 100m and 4 x 400m relays and 4 x 400m mixed relays events.

Results of all field events held in indoor tracks, as well as races of 200m or more, shall be accepted.

Results from events of 200m or more obtained on oversized indoor tracks will not be accepted (more than 200m).

### Confirmation of quotas

No later than April 30, 2025, APA will confirm to Panam Sports and the NOCs the places qualified by the NOCs.

No later than May 5, 2025, the NOCs must confirm to Panam Sports and APA the places they will use.

### Reallocation of unused quotas

If necessary, no later than May 7, 2025, APA will reallocate the declined quotas to the next NOC (based on the Pan American ranking) that has not qualified yet.

The NOCs that receive reallocated quotas must confirm their participation no later than May 9, 2025.

### Qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games

In Athletics, all gold medalists of individual events will obtain direct qualification for the Lima 2027 Pan American Games. A total of 19 places per gender (38 in total) will be allocated in these competitions.

The places obtained are for the athletes, not for the country. If the athlete who earned the quota cannot participate in the Lima 2027 Pan American Games, the quota will be lost and may not be transferred to the country or to any other athlete placed in another position in the II Junior Pan American Games Asuncion 2025.

In the Asuncion 2025 Junior Pan American Games, the 20km race walk athletes may obtain their qualification mark for the Tokyo 2025 World Athletics Championship.
