The Jamaica College Sports Development Committee invites you to our 31st staging of the Purewater/R Danny Williams/JC Track Meet on January 6th 2023 at 8:00 am. As one of the oldest track meets on the local track and field calendar, our meet is fully endorsed by the JAAA and is used as an ISSA qualifying meet for Boys & Girls Athletics Championships.

The events offered are as follows:

Track Events: 100m, 800m, 3000m, 5000m, 70m hurdles, 80m hurdles 100m hurdles 110m hurdles, 400m hurdles.

Field Events: High Jump, Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, Discus Javelin and Pole Vault.

PLEASE NOTE that the Triple Jump, Discus and Javelin events will be contested on Friday January 5, 2024 during the running of the ON DI Run Speedfest. All other events will be contested on Saturday.

A complete order of events will be shared soon.

Entry Fees and procedures are as follows: -

A team entry of \$15,000 for teams consisting of 15 or more athletes, whilst the teams with 15 or less will pay \$1,000 per athlete. Please note there is a team restriction of 4 athletes per event except for the 100m where there is a restriction of 3. All registration must be done at <http://www.entryformsja.com/> **Deadline for entries is Sunday January 1st, 2024 there will be no entry or changes accepted on the day of the meet.** The performance list will be published on Tuesday January 3rd 2024 and all changes must be made by emailing ondirun@gmail.com and d.johnson@jc.edu.jm no later than January 5th 2024.

Parking & Tents

Teams will be allowed to set up team tents in the warmup area located on the top playing field, using the designated areas. School buses will be allowed to enter through our main entrance of the school to do their drop off and will then exit through the main exit gate and directed to the Ashenhiem stadium parking lot, located off Ravina Avenue.

Spectator Entry

All spectators must enter through the stadium parking lot located on Ravina Avenue. Patrons must pay \$1000 to enter the venue.
